





What is the Chain & Forge?

The Chain & Forge is the first major redevelopment on Granville Island since the 1970s. Iconic in nature, it's one of the first buildings seen when driving on to the Island, framed by two towering murals designed by Musqueam artist, weaver, and knowledge keeper, Deborah Sparrow.

Located just steps from the famous Public Market, this building marks the first redevelopment in the creation of the Market District; envisioned in the Granville Island 2040: Bridging Past & Future Report as incorporating and forming an extension of the Public Market. The Market District will be a new retail destination in the City; providing a platform for inspiring and innovative businesses to thrive. With the aim of enriching night-time activities on Island, priority will be given to prospective tenants that can remain open into the evening hours.



What is the Chain & Forge?

The Chain & Forge's central location and proximity to the vibrant surrounding streetscape will be further complemented by a gathering space directly at the doorsteps of these new commercial-retail spaces.

Opportunities for culinary and event programming in this gathering space are countless, creating additional draws to the building and the spaces directly adjacent to it.
